

CMCS 2017 GUIDELINES FOR POSTER PRESENTATIONS

- 1) The maximum poster dimensions of 44 1/2" width x 42" height (approx. 113 cm width x 106 cm height) must be respected. A0 size (118.9 cm x 84.1 cm) will be approximately 1.8" (approx. 4.5 cm) higher than the board. A poster in this format is acceptable if you don't use the bottom part (1.8" or 4.5cm)
- 2) Posters should not be crowded with text. If supplemental material is desired, you may hand out information sheets to those viewing your poster. However, ensure that there is enough text on the poster so that it is easy to understand your work even if you are not at your poster.
- 3) Each poster must have a top label indicating the title of the poster, the names of the authors and their affiliations. The size of the characters for the title should be at least 0.8" (2 cm) high.
- 4) Material to affix your poster to the display boards will be provided to you by the conference and will already be on your poster board when you arrive.
- 5) Poster text should be large enough to be read from a distance of 3' (1 meter) or more. This is possible using a letter size of at least 0.4" (1 cm). Font sizes 30-50 are ideal.
- 6) Keep illustrative material simple. Charts, drawings and illustrations are usually similar to those used in making slides - preferably with bolder, heavier figures. Simple use of colour is effective for adding emphasis.
- 7) Simple "Introduction" and "Conclusion" sections are usually helpful. When feasible, use graphs for demonstrating qualitative relationships, use tables for precise numerical values.
- 8) Do not fold posters; try to carry them in an appropriate container. Do not mail poster presentations in advance, they may not arrive in time; bring them with you to the Conference.
- 9) Please note that there will be no audio-visual equipment in the poster area.
- 10) Leaving some business cards and/or adding a small photo of yourself may be helpful for others to connect with you.


Poster Session:
